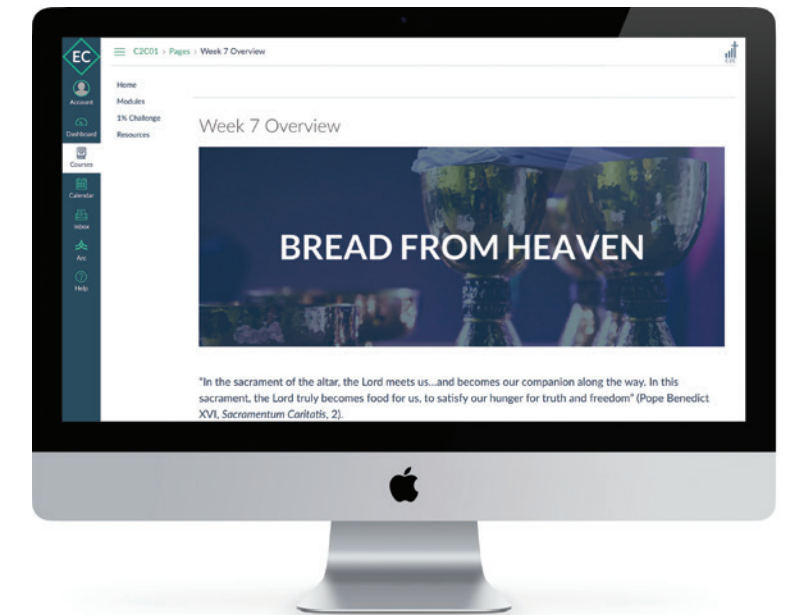
Connection to Christ (C2C) Online Discipleship Formation System

The pathway to mature discipleship passes through terrain that the saints, great teachers, and the magisterium know well and have identified for us. Yes, the Lord attends to individual needs on this path, but a pilgrim person must visit specific spiritual “way stations” to receive what they need to become disciples. Order matters. Content matters.

The C2C System creates these way stations online: an easily accessible and appealing medium for modern Catholics en route to a deeper love for Jesus, richer prayer, greater devotion to the scriptures and sacraments, and stronger virtue.

An individual seeker will be able to find C2C on the web. Pastoral leaders will have a reliable resource to make more disciples more quickly on campus and in parishes. C2C's bite-size interactive sessions of video, thoughtful writing, and inspiration for new ways to pray make it easy for anyone to move step-by-step daily into the heart of the Father through Jesus.

*The complete C2C will be live by fall of 2018, but EC **Reach More** ministries are using it this year to evangelize and catechize.*
